

# Free public transit pass



## Subsidy program for low-income seniors

The City of Saint-Lambert is offering free "Accès 65 HORS POINTE" transit passes to low-income seniors (annual gross income of less than \$32,000 for an individual or less than \$42,000 for a family) aged 65 and older. This pass is valid from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021.

The "Accès 65 HORS POINTE" transit pass allows qualified seniors to make an unlimited number of trips using the regular transit or paratransit services of the RTL network, during the following off-peak hours:

- Off-peak daytime hours: 9 a.m. to 3:29 p.m.
- Off-peak evening hours: 6:30 p.m. to 3:59 a.m.
- Saturdays, Sundays and statutory holidays.

The City is pleased to offer this service, whose goal is to encourage its seniors to stay active and take part in activities being offered in the agglomeration, while helping to relieve them of the worry of the cost of transportation.

### How to obtain your free pass

All you need to do is come to City Hall (55 Argyle Avenue) with the following documents in hand:

- A **reduced-fare OPUS card** with photo;
- A **proof of residency**: copy of a tax bill or utility bill (telephone, electricity, etc.);
- A **piece of identification**: valid driver's licence, health insurance card or passport;
- A copy of your 2019 or 2020 **federal notice of assessment**;
- The completed **application form** (see below).

If your application meets all the requirements, your "Accès 65 HORS POINTE" transit pass will be loaded onto your OPUS card. You can

renew your pass on July 1 by going to City Hall with a new proof of residency in hand.

### To obtain your reduced-fare OPUS card with photo

If you do not have a reduced-fare OPUS card with photo, you can obtain one for \$15 from the ticket office located in wing A of the Longueuil terminal, at 120 Place Charles-Le Moyne. The ticket office is open 7 days a week, between 5:30 a.m. and 12:00 a.m.

### Be sure to bring:

- The completed **application form for a reduced-fare OPUS card with photo** (the form can be downloaded from [www.saint-lambert.ca](http://www.saint-lambert.ca) or obtained at the terminal);
- A valid **piece of photo identification** (driver's licence, health insurance card, or passport).
